Project: Bunbury Civic Centre & Council Chambers

Project Profile: The new Bunbury Civic Centre is a three level Green Star rated venue, which has been fully refurbished and doubled in size from the original building. The building accommodates Bunbury City Council delegates and staff. The facilities include a new Council audio visual conferencing system, function room, 3 storeys of office workspace, separate meeting rooms and Councilor Offices complete with ensuites, numerous kitchens and administration offices, staff recreation and lunch areas. The facility is centrally located in Bunbury, opposite Bunbury Police Station and Law Courts.

Perkins Builders engaged Nilsen Electric and WMA (Wright McKay And Associates, Consultants) for the design, installation and commissioning of the total electrical, generator manual changeover facility, load shedding, fire detection, EWIS, audio visual, monitored emergency lighting control, Clipsal C-Bus building management and security management access swipe card control system, MATV and category 6 communication systems. In addition the project involved the relocation of Bunbury Central Telstra Exchange via fibre optic cabling from the park adjacent to the new communications room.
