

Nilsen was contracted by Watpac Constructions to carry out general electrical, security, audio visual and communications services for the Museum of Contemporary Art Project Located in The Rocks, Sydney City.

The 16,700m² project includes the refurbishment of the existing building along with a new extension. This included 5 new galleries, dedicated multimedia room, digital classroom, two practical studios, a 129 seat lecture theater, 'Bella Room' for children with special needs and an entire floor dedicated to the MCA Collection, in turn offering a major national resource for education and interpretative programs.

Works Includes Main Switchboards, Distribution boards, Dynalite Lighting Control, Communications cabling throughout the building and a new Communications Room, Access Control, Security (Including CCTV), Theater and Stage Lighting, Lighting Bars, Motorised Projection Screens, External and Landscape Lighting, Audio Visual and provision for the connection to BMCS.
