Project: Midland Health Campus Data Cabling Installation

Project Profile: The St John of God Midland Public Hospital will offer a comprehensive range of new and expanded general hospital services and will have 307 beds. In addition, the private operator will provide 60 private patient beds.

The new Midland Health Campus will deliver free care to the people of Perth's north-eastern corridor and the Wheatbelt from late 2015. It is the first new hospital in the area in more than 50 years.

Nilsen were engaged for the installation of the structured data cabling system at the new hospital campus. The installation was carried out using a Panduit solution for the copper and an Emtelle blown fibre solution. Just over 5500 data outlets were installed throughout the hospital, being fed by 19 separate communications rooms.

Engaging a team of 6 highly specialised data and communications staff to perform the installation, Nilsen commenced work in May 2013, with the project completed in July 2015.
